Case Study

Allam Diabetes Centre, Hull Royal Infirmary



Project details

SRS were contracted as the mechanical and electrical design and build contractor to complete the new build of the Allam Diabetes Centre at Hull Royal Infirmary. This state-of-the-art Allam Diabetes Centre provides 2100m² of new floor space for outpatients, training and research, and will become a local landmark at the front of Hull Royal Infirmary.

What we did

- Installed a new plant room and air source heat pump to provide the building with heating, ventilation, air conditioning, LTWH and domestic water supplies.
- Power and LED lighting was fitted throughout the building.
- A full security system was installed including CCTV, door access, intruder alarms throughout the building across 3 levels.
- Full fire alarm system connected through the building.
- Installed a new data network for computers, phone lines and to run technology required in the building.
- A bespoke nurse call system was fitted for patient monitoring

Case Study

Intensive Care Unit, Hull Royal Infirmary

Project details

SRS were the main mechanical and electrical contractor on this multi-million-pound Intensive Care Unit (ICU). The ICU at Hull Royal Infirmary opened in 2021 for critically ill and injured patients from all over Yorkshire and Northern Lincolnshire.

What we did

Our Mechanical team

- Installed 2 new air handling unit plant rooms and one roof plant room to house the chiller plant.
- Provided 2 new chillers that deliver chilled water to the building and an air source heat pump to provide the ICU ward with energy efficient services.
- Services in the building LTHW, domestic water supplies and above ground drainage
- Air conditioning to IPS and UPS rooms and hub rooms.
- Installed medical gases to 24 bed bays with all associated plant.
- Supplied and installed 2 new air handling units and all ventilation to the rooms.

Our Electrical team

- Installed power and LED lighting, new mains panel and supplies to the building.
- Installed feature lighting into the patient bed bays - the back lit panels show cloud images to improve patient wellbeing.
- Data services to supply data network for computers and technology required within the unit. Alongside additional data for the ICU patient monitoring.
- Integrated Power System (IPS) and Uninterrupted Power Supply (UPS) systems to provide an electrical back up system in case of an electrical failure.
- 2 new electrical plant rooms which provide the building with services.
- Full fire alarm system.
- Provided services to the medical pendants and patient hoists to assist nurses in moving patients across 24 bed bays.
- A bespoke nurse call system for patient monitoring.



A note from SRS

The ICU project has been a large-scale installation for SRS and the team have worked tirelessly to deliver an M&E project of this size. As a company local to Hull, SRS are proud to have employed local talent to support and deliver a local project. SRS are delighted to know they have worked as part of a team to deliver a project to their local community which will save lives.



Case Study

Pharmacy Relocation, Hull Royal Infirmary

Project details

SRS were contracted as the mechanical and electrical design and build contractor to relocate the pharmacy within Hull Royal Infirmary. HRI is the main accident and emergency centre in Hull, it employs over 8000 employees.

What we did

- Installed a dispensary robot which enables the staff to locate medicine quickly and sort through medication.
- Added new facilities such as a cold room store, office spaces and amenities.
- Our mechanical work involved the installation of ventilation, air conditioning, LTHW, domestic water supplies and a cold room store.
- Electrical elements we installed to the project involved power and data installation, BMS controls, new LED lighting, emergency lighting and fire alarm installation. This comprised of wiring for the new computers, wiring supplies to the robot and wiring supplies to the cold room.
- Hand washing stations for the dispensary team were also installed to help infection control within the hospital, using Integrated Plumbing System Units.



A note from SRS

This project was technically advanced, and the equipment was expensive technology that needed precision and skill to install. The outcome was very satisfying for the team to have been involved with delivering an innovative project for The Hull University Teaching Hospitals NHS Trust in partnership with the Helix team.



Arco Distribution Centre, Hull



Project details

Arco is the market-leading supplier for PPE in the United Kingdom. Due to the growth of the firm, they required a new 20,439m² extension, which is equivalent to almost 3 football pitches. This extension allowed Arco to double its capacity and logistics. With a height of 19m, the extension can hold approximately 40,000 pallets.

What we did

- The SRS mechanical team worked from the start of the project to install a full mechanical service for this project including heating, water supplies and ventilation.
- Installation of over 500 meters of fusion weld and steel welded gas pipe in a range of sizes from 90mm to 315mm pipe which supplied 5 external air handling units and 9 internal warm air heaters.
- Fitted hot and cold distribution services, above ground drainage and sanitary ware to the warehouse, offices and canteen facilities.

The Arco Distribution Centre is an iconic building on the Hull skyline and SRS are delighted to have helped Arco complete their new distribution centre in East Yorkshire.

Case Study

COVID Wards 37 & 38, Hull Royal Infirmary

Project details

At Hull Royal Infirmary in the middle of the COVID global pandemic they needed to create 2 brand new wards to be used exclusively for COVID-19 patients. SRS were on site as the design & build contractors to implement the mechanical and electrical elements of the project. The wards each had 26 beds, shower spaces, ward kitchens, utility rooms and storage space.

What we did

- Power and data
- Nurse call systems
- LED lighting
- Medical trunking
- Full security system
- Ventilation
- Full hot and cold water system
- Integrated panel systems

The project was delivered in a very short timescale at a time that the construction industry was under enormous pressure. 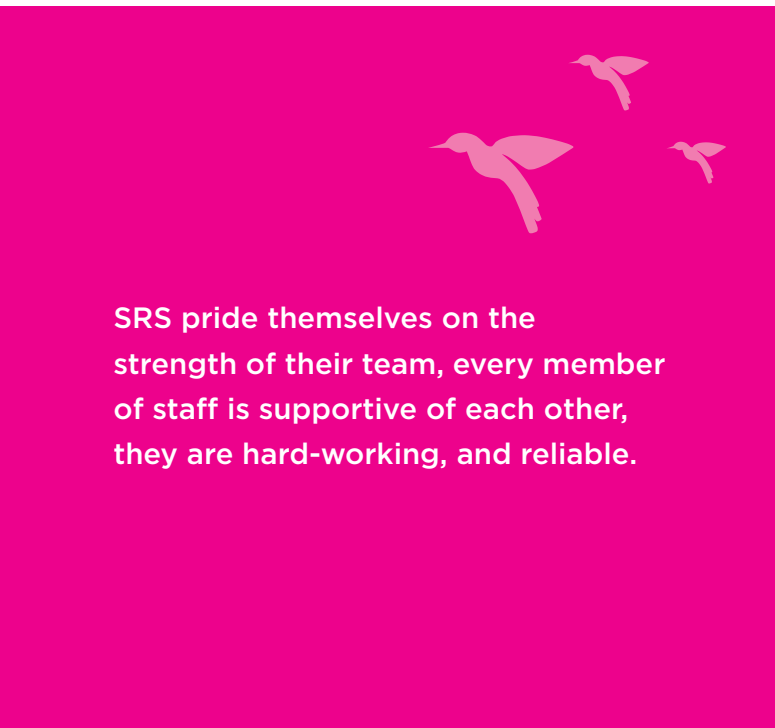

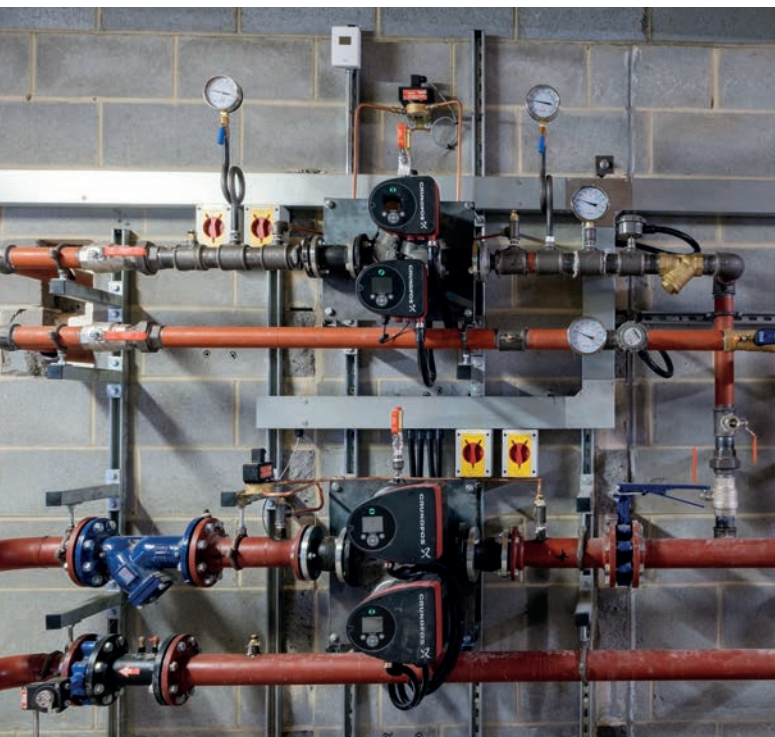
